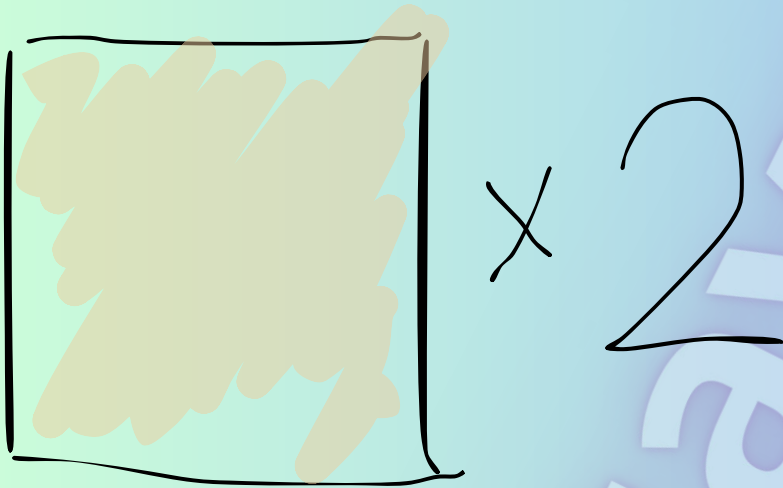


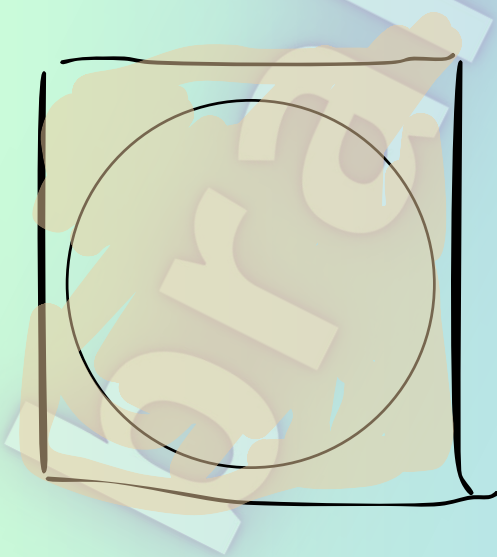
LET'S SCREW A WORD-LEARNING WHEEL



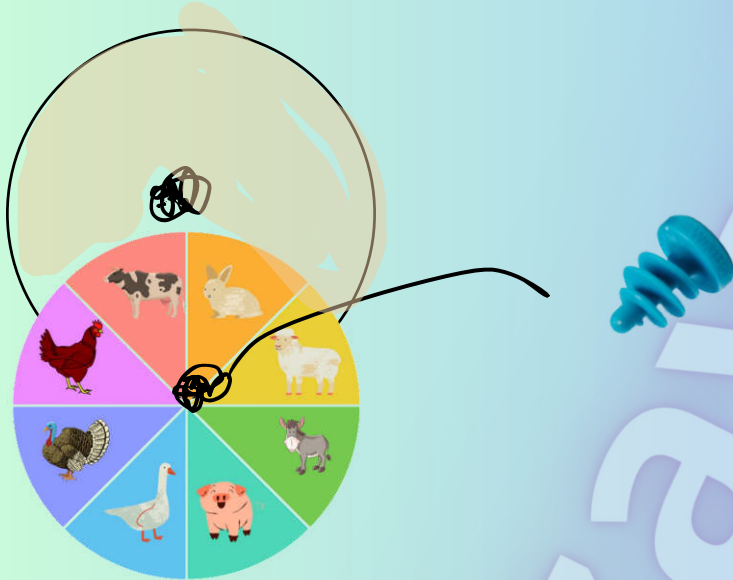
1. You'll need 2 pieces of cardboard. The first one should be square or rectangular for the base, and the second one should be for the circle.



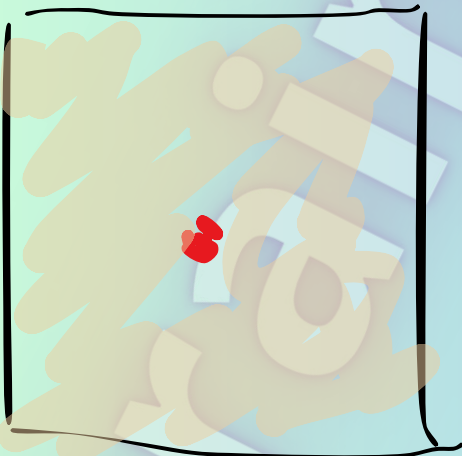
2. Print out the circles with pictures from the document, cut them out, and trace them onto the cardboard so the sizes match (you need one cardboard circle).



3. Use a hole punch to make a hole in the center of the circle and the paper, then connect them with a long screw.



4. Take the square base and make a hole in the center.



5. Add another screw to the top of the circle to create a handle for spinning the wheel.



6. Put the wheel onto the base, making sure the screw fits into the hole, and spin the wheel using the handle. You can also add another screw on the side of the base as a pointer.



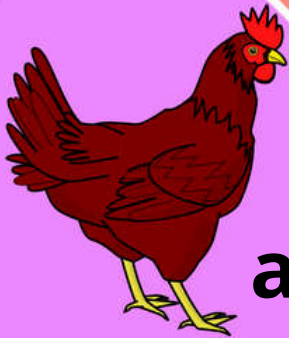
7. Your word-learning wheel is ready!

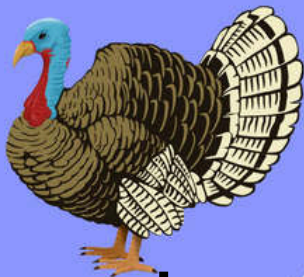

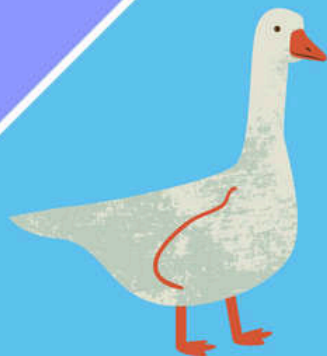
